## Soil Aeration Workshop Recording Available

As part of the Washington State Conservation Commission's Sustainable Farms and Field's (SFF) Program, PCD applied for funding this past spring to provide cost share for Kaukiki farm in Lakebay to purchase a combination soil aerator-seeder for a local farmer. This farmer offered to show off the equipment in a partner workshop with PCD. Workshop participants learned about the equipment and how aeration of compacted soils will increase crop, forage production, and long-term carbon sequestration and reduce carbon dioxide equivalent (greenhouse gases, GHG) emissions while reducing runoff and nutrient loss, and increasing water and nutrient absorption rates. 


### South Prairie Creek Preserve Work Party


