CONTEST RULES

- Any media may be used; paint, crayon, colored pencil, charcoal, stickers, paper, or other materials.
- All posters must be created by an individual student, rather than a team of students.
- Entry must be contestant's original creation and may not be traced from photographs or other artists' published works.
- The 2019 Stewardship theme "Life in the Soil: Dig Deeper" must be included on the front side of each poster submission to be eligible for the national poster contest.
- Each entry must be submitted with an entry form to be eligible for judging. The form must be completed and signed by a parent or guardian.
- NACD encourages each student to do their own work. Note: Entries with student handwriting and coloring will score better than those designed, drawn, and colored by adult assistance!
