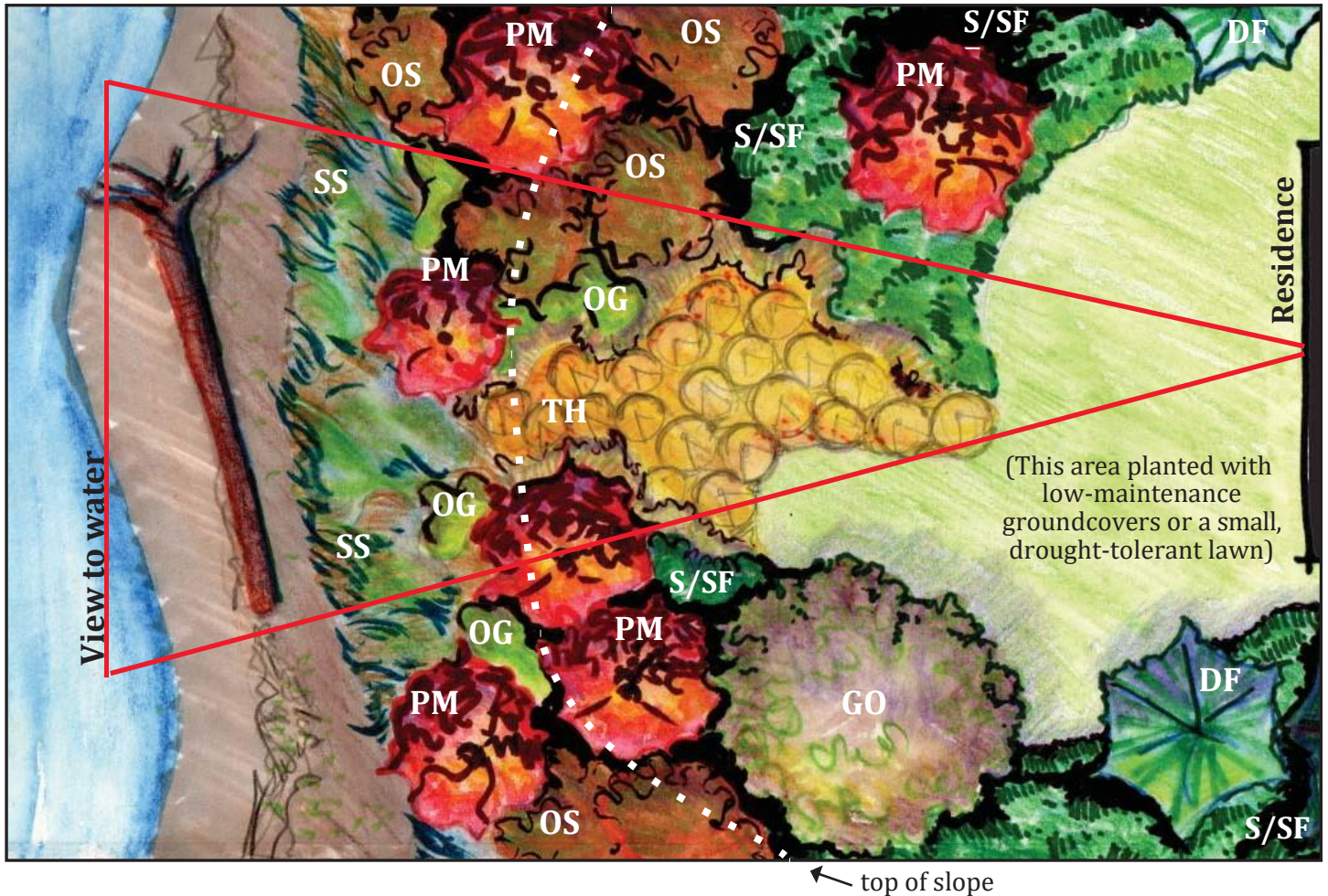





SAMPLE PLANTING PLAN: MARINE SHORELINE

Pacific Northwest Native Plants




SYMBOL TREE / LARGE SHRUB

-  **Pacific Madrone** (*Arbutus menziesii*)
-  **Douglas-fir** (*Pseudotsuga menziesii*)
...Grand Fir (*Abies grandis*)
...Shore Pine (*Pinus contorta v. contorta*)
-  **Garry oak** (*Quercus garryana*)
...Pacific Crabapple (*Malus fusca*)
...Serviceberry (*Amelanchier alnifolia*)

SYMBOL SHRUB | GROUNDCOVER

-  **Ocean Spray** (*Holodiscus discolor*)
...Wax Myrtle (*Myrica californica*)
...Thimbleberry (*Rubus parviflorus*)
-  **Salal** (*Gaultheria shallon*)
...Sword fern (*Polystichum munitum*)
...Snowberry (*Symphoricarpos alba*)
-  **Tall Oregon Grape** (*Mahonia/Berberis aquifolium*)
...Nootka Rose (*Rosa nutkana*)
...Hookers Willow (*Salix hookeriana*)
-  **Tufted Hairgrass** (*Deschampsia cespitosa*)
...Coastal Lupine (*Lupinus littoralis*)
...Coastal Strawberry (*Fragaria chiloensis*)
-  **Seashore saltgrass** (*Distichlis spicata*)
...Silverweed (*Potentilla pacifica*)
...Henderson's Checker-mallow (*Sidalcea hendersonii*)

 **View to water**
View created by carefully pruning trees and selecting low-growing shrubs. (Avoid completely removing plants -this usually causes erosion problems)
